

PROPOSED LAYOUT

- COACH HOUSE AREA SHOULD BE LARGE ENOUGH TO PROVIDE A SHELTER AND PICNIC TABLE AND ROOM FOR BICYCLES.

LOWER WALL AND INFILL DOORWAY OR REMOVE AND RESTORE STONE WALL (DEPENDS ON OWNERSHIP BOUNDARY)

WALL TO BE LOWERED AND MADE GOOD - POSSIBLE SITE FOR NOTICE BOARD

BRICK WALL TO BE REPAIRED

TREES & SHRUBS AND LOWER PLANTING (ADDITIONAL PLANTING INTENDED)

BRICK WALL TO BE LOWERED TO FORM RETAINING WALL

WALKER'S FARM

POSSIBLE SHELTER + SEATING

AREA APPROX 7m x 5m

FOOTPATH (TO BE MADE GOOD)

KERB EDGING TO PLANTING

LAY-BY (1 VEHICLE)

- FLOOR OF COACH HOUSE AREA COULD BE LEVELLED AND COVERED WITH RECYCLED BRICKS
- BRICKS COULD ALSO FORM BASE SUPPORTS FOR SHELTER AND PLANTERS
- A POSSIBLE 'GAZEBO' SHELTER WITH ONE OR TWO BENCHES OR EVEN A PICNIC TABLE - TO FORM A REST STATION FOR WALKERS AND CYCLISTS. A HEAVY DUTY ONE WOULD COST ABOUT £2,000 BUT ONE COULD BE MADE USING RE-CYCLED TIMBERS AND EVEN EXISTING ROOF TILES.
- OTHER IDEAS -
 - BIRD BOXES
 - BIRD BATH IN GARDEN AREA.
 - USING ROOF TILES TO CAP WALLS
 - REPAIRING THE PHONE BOX
